Nominations for Referee of the Year Awards

There are 7 Referee of the Year Awards given annually by the NCYSA, NCASA, and NCSRA to acknowledge and honor the contributions and achievements of outstanding individuals providing referee services to the soccer community. Each award has specific criteria and each award recipient receives certain specified opportunities and supplies, depending on the award.

All award recipients receive an invitation for themselves and 3 guests to attend the annual awards luncheon held at the Annual General Meeting of NCYSA and NCASA usually the last Sunday in January. All recipients also receive an NCSRA embroidered polo shirt, track suit and back pack. Below are listed the seven awards and the sponsoring associations for each award. For each of these awards there is a link that lists the award specific criteria. Below all of the listed awards there is a link to make a nomination. The nomination link will generate a specific email nomination form which when completed and emailed will be automatically distributed to the appropriate recipients. The proponent of any nominee selected will also be informed by NCSRA of that person's selection.
